### **The Centre for Study of Insurance Operations (CSIO) releases Vehicle Inspection Authorization Form for Ontario**

**Toronto, February 24, 2000** - As part of its forms initiative, CSIO today released an industry standard Vehicle Inspection Authorization Form for use in Ontario. Vehicle inspections are mandatory in Ontario with most new business transactions. The form, which is completed by the broker, outlines the details of the scheduled inspection for the insured. Daphne Horn, CSIO Standards Specialist, explained that "this single industry standard form will bring new efficiencies to the broker channel by replacing the many existing company unique forms that are in use today".

The Vehicle Inspection Authorization Form is the first form to be provided electronic format and is available to members via CSIO's web-site, [www.csio.com](http://www.csio.com). As part of this announcement, Klaas Westera, CSIO President, stated that "this form is just the beginning of an ambitious CSIO forms initiative" and that "more exciting things are on the drawing board for delivery this year".
